

TERMS AND CONDITION OF REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP

The Japanese Language Society of Malaysia (JLSM)

The Japanese Language Society of Malaysia (JLSM) is a non-profit organization registered with the Registrar of Societies Malaysia on 11th November 1968.

Registration

1. Registration and membership is open to all natural persons over eleven years of age who have an interest in learning and promoting of the Japanese language and culture as well as being part of the cultural exchange programs. Those under 18 years old must first obtain the consent of their parent or guardian.
2. Only online application is accepted. Incomplete application will NOT be accepted.
3. Membership application is subjected to approval by JLSM Executive Committee (EXCO) and the EXCO may reject any application without attesting any reason(s).
4. 'Associate Membership' will be accorded once their application is accepted and membership fees is received.
5. After 2 years, 'Associate Members' may apply to be upgraded to 'Ordinary Member' whereby they may participate in the General Meetings and can be elected as Members of the Executive Committee. Such application has to be supported by 2 current 'Ordinary Members' and subjected to approval by the EXCO.
6. Membership is non-transferrable. Any fees paid is NOT refundable nor transferrable.

Membership Benefits

All members, irrespective of its class, may

- a) participate in any classes or activities organized by JLSM subject to their respective terms and conditions;
- b) access to JLSM Learners Resource Centre; and
- c) borrow any cultural items listed.

Termination of Membership

1. Members may resign their membership with JLSM at any time by communicating their decision by email to jlsm.enquiries@gmail.com.
2. Membership may also be terminated if
 - a) the member is found violating the Constitution of JLSM.
 - b) any of the clause on the termination of membership in the Constitution is fulfilled
 - c) the information declared by the member in his/her application form is fraud.

Rejected Application

JLSM will not entertain any enquiries on rejected application. However, rejected applicant may register again (if they wish) 90 days after the date of rejection of their previous application.
